

# 2026 Straight River Days Medallion Hunt Rules and Regulations



**All contest rules and decisions are final.**

## **Clue Communication:**

Straight River Days Medallion Hunt clues will be given out at designated events and on the Straight River Days Facebook page.

## **Medallion Location:**

The medallion is hidden outdoors within the city limits of Medford, Minnesota. It is not on residential or private land. The medallion may be covered or inside loose natural or artificial materials (i.e., leaves, sticks, wrappers, boxes, paper, stone, etc.)

## **How big is the medallion?**

The 2026 gold medallion is approximately two inches in diameter and ¼ inch thick. In the center of the gold leaf-bordered medallion is a white disc with the Straight River Days logo centered in the middle and "2026 Medallion Hunt" imprinted on it.



## **Who is Eligible?**

Individuals under the age of 18 must have the permission of a parent or legal guardian to participate in the Hunt. Alyse Miller, Erin Sammon, Pat Heger, and their immediate family members are not eligible. You can hunt in a group, but there is only 1 prize, which must be shared among the parties involved.

## **What to do when the Medallion is found:**

When the Straight River Days Medallion is found, please contact Erin at 507-456-5119 to claim your prize. Except where legally prohibited, by accepting the prize, the winner grants permission to the Medford Civic Club to use his or her name, photograph, voice, and/or likeness for advertising and/or publicity without compensation.

## **What if Medallion is not found?**

If the Straight River Days Medallion is not found by 8:00 pm Sunday, June 21st, 2026, additional, more specific clues will be posted until the medallion is found. If the medallion is not found or turned in by Monday, June 22nd, 2026, the Medford Civic Club reserves the right to discontinue the contest if deemed necessary.
